**ORDER GRANTING REQUEST TO WITHDRAW APPEAL**

On May 22, 2019, the Board of Alien Labor Certification Appeals (“BALCA”) received a letter from Jeremiah Copper on behalf of Tributary Whitewater Tours, LLC (“Employer”) requesting administrative review of the Certifying Officer’s Notice of Decision-Denial in the above-captioned H-2B temporary labor certification matter. This case has been assigned to the undersigned Administrative Law Judge for hearing and decision. The appeal file was received on June 11, 2019. A briefing order was issued on June 12, 2019, setting the deadline for closing briefs for June 20, 2019.
