ORDER OF REMAND

This case arises from the request of Employer BEP/Lyman LLC, d/b/a Carpentry Contractors Company for review of the Certifying Officer's (CO) Final Determination in an H-2B temporary alien labor certification matter. On September 17, 2020, the CO filed a Motion to Remand. The CO asserts that she and the Employer have reached an agreement in this proceeding and have determined that the Employer's H-2B application for temporary labor certification should be remanded to the CO for further processing. Further, the CO represents that the Employer consents to the Motion.

For good cause shown, it is ORDERED that the CO's Motion to Remand is GRANTED. The Employer's H-2B application for temporary labor certification in this proceeding is REMANDED to the CO for further processing.
