ORDER REMANDING CASE

This case arises from the request by Lafayette Portland West Lafayette Hotels, dba Fireside Inn Portland, (“Employer”) for review of the Certifying Officer’s (“CO”) decision to deny an application for temporary alien labor certification under the H-2B non-immigrant program. 20 C.F.R. § 655 *et seq.* On March 24, 2020, this matter was assigned to me. On March 25, 2020, I issued a Notice of Docketing and Expedited Briefing Schedule. On March 27, 2020, the CO, through counsel, filed a Certifying Officer’s Motion to Remand (the “Motion”). The Motion stated that the CO and the Employer had reached an agreement, and that the Employer consents to the Motion being granted.

Accordingly, and good cause appearing, the Motion is GRANTED and this case is remanded to the Employment and Training Administration, Office of Foreign Labor Certification for further handling.
