ORDER OF REMAND

This matter arises under 8 U.S.C. § 101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b) of the Immigration and Nationality Act, and the H-2B rules and regulations governing temporary labor certification. On September 9, 2020, I issued a *Notice of Docketing and Preliminary Order* scheduling an initial conference call for September 10, 2020.

Shortly after the conference call on September 10, 2020, the Certifying Officer filed a *Motion to Remand* indicating the parties had reached an agreement and the case should be remanded to the agency for additional processing. *See* 20 C.F.R. § 655.61(e)(3).

Accordingly, it is **ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for further action consistent with the parties' agreement.
