**ORDER OF REMAND**

**1. Basis for Order.** Certifying Officer filed a motion to remand requesting the undersigned remand this matter to the Chicago National Processing Center, Office of Foreign Labor Certification, Employment and Training Administration (“Agency”) for further processing. Certifying Officer represents that Employer consents to granting of this motion to remand.

**2. Applicable Law and Analysis.**

Pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 18.70(b), a party may move to remand the matter to the referring agency. A remand order must include any terms or conditions and should state the reason for the remand.

Certifying Officer represents that Certifying Officer and Employer have reached agreement in this matter and have determined that Employer’s H-2B application should be remanded to the Agency for further processing. Certifying Officer also represents that Employer consents to the granting of this motion to remand. Considering the position of the parties represented in this motion, the undersigned concludes that remand to the Agency for further processing is appropriate in this matter.

**3. Ruling and Specific Terms of Order.** Certifying Officer’s motion to remand is granted, and this matter is hereby **REMANDED** to the Agency for further processing of Employer’s H-2B application.
