**DECISION AND ORDER APPROVING CONSENT FINDINGS**

This is a proceeding under the H-2B provisions of the Immigration and Nationality Act, (“INA”), 8 U.S.C. § 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b) *et seq*, and the applicable regulations issued thereunder at 20 C.F.R. Part 655, Subpart A.

On January 26, 2015, the Administrator and Stan Sweeney, LLC, filed Consent Findings resolving all issues in dispute in this case relating to Stan Sweeney, LLC’s contest of the Administrator’s findings regarding its compliance with the employment of H-2B workers and the H-2B provisions of the INA. I have reviewed the parties’ Consent Findings, and I find them to be fair and adequate. The Consent Findings are attached hereto and made a part hereof.

Accordingly, **IT IS ORDERED** that the Consent Findings be, and the same hereby are **APPROVED**.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that civil money penalties in the total amount of **\$5,600.00** be paid by Stan Sweeney, LLC to the Wage and Hour Division of the Department of Labor within thirty (30) days of January 31, 2015, to the extent that Stan Sweeney, LLC has not already done so. **IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this total amount shall be deemed to be full satisfaction of the civil money penalties claim against Stan Sweeney, LLC arising out of its employment of H-2B workers.
