ORDER OF DISMISSAL
AND ORDER CANCELLING HEARING

On May 8, 2015, I received by fax (prior permission had been given) the Prosecuting Party's Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice and Supplemental Response to Respondent's Motion to Dismiss (I received a hard copy on May 12, 2015). On May 14, 2015, I received Respondent's Statement of Position, which does not oppose the Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice.

Upon review of both parties' submissions, I find good cause to grant the Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice. I also find good cause to cancel the currently-scheduled hearing of this matter. I make no ruling on Respondent's currently-pending Motion to Dismiss as I find it unnecessary to do so, given my ruling on the Prosecuting Party's Motion for Voluntary Dismissal Without Prejudice. 2. The hearing of this matter currently set for June 9, 2015 at 9:00 a.m. in St. Louis, Missouri, continuing if necessary to June 10, 2015, is CANCELLED.
