DECISION AND ORDER

Pursuant to 29 C.F.R. § 18.71, the parties to the action, Prosecuting Party, the Administrator of the Wage and Hour Division, United States Department of Labor and Respondent, Lola Ramirez d/b/a JLQ Concessions and Pepe's Mariscos, have negotiated and executed this Settlement Agreement and Consent Findings including Exhibits A and B (a copy of which is appended hereto and the recitations of which are deemed to constitute any findings and conclusions). The Settlement Agreement and Consent Findings with Exhibits A and B constitute a full and final resolution of this action and of all issues raised by the Determination Letter issued to Lola Ramirez, Owner JLQ Concessions and Pepe's Mariscos on June 30, 2016 with respect to the employment of H-2B workers and the H-2B provisions of the Immigration and Naturalization Act ("INA"), as amended, 8 U.S.C. §1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(b) *et seq.*

Accordingly, it is ORDERED that:

1. The Settlement Agreement and Consent Findings along with Exhibits A and B are hereby APPROVED and attached hereto as part of the record;
2. The parties are bound by the terms of said instrument and shall comply therewith;
3. Back wages of \$29,950.00 and civil money penalties of \$15,000.00 shall be paid by Respondent to the Department of Labor on or before the dates due as set forth in the Consent Findings and Exhibits;

4. Final and timely payment of the amounts in Paragraph 3, above, shall be deemed to be full and final satisfaction of all contested issues arising of this action; and
5. The entire record on which this matter is based is contained in the Administrator's Determination Letter, Respondent's letter requesting hearing, the Settlement Agreement and Consent Findings along with Exhibits A and B and this Decision and Order.
