**ORDER CANCELLING HEARING AND DISMISSING CASE**

This case is grounded in the Workforce Investment Act. 29 U.S.C. § 2801 et seq. On July 22, 2008, the Complainant requested a hearing from the Office of Administrative Law Judges to appeal the denial of an award. By letter dated November 12, 2008, the Complainant notified me that it intended to withdraw its appeal. By Order dated November 14, 2008, I informed the Respondent of the Complainant's request to withdraw its appeal, and directed the Respondent to respond, within 10 days, with any objections.
