**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

By letter dated October 18, 2012, counsel for the Complainant submitted a Stipulation of Dismissal, requesting that this proceeding be dismissed with prejudice. This Stipulation, which has been signed by counsel for the Complainant and counsel for the Respondent, states that the Grant Officer for the U.S. Department of Labor has awarded the National Urban League a Young Adult Offender grant under Solicitation for Grant Applications 09-05 that became available for award to the National Urban League as next in line due to its panel score, because the initial awardee had ceased operations. Thus, all issues raised by this case have been resolved.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this case is dismissed with prejudice.
