DISMISSAL ORDER

This matter arises under the Workforce Investment Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2801 *et seq.* On November 19, 2012, my administrative staff contacted the parties to coordinate a formal hearing date. On November, 20, 2012, the parties requested a continuance to pursue settlement negotiations. November 20, 2012, I issued an *Order*, directing the parties to file a status update by March 1, 2013.

On February 27, 2013, Respondent submitted a *Joint Status Update and Motion For Additional Time to Continue Negotiations*. On March 12, 2013, I issued an *Order Granting Extension of Time*, directing the parties to file a status update by April 30, 2013.

On April 15, 2013, I received a letter from Respondent, requesting additional time to continue settlement discussions. Pursuant to my order issued April 29, 2013, I granted this request. On May 31, 2013, Complainant requested another extension, and by telephonic contact my staff notified the parties it had been granted.

On June 18, 2013, I received a letter from the Complainant, formally withdrawing its Notice of Appeal, and requesting a dismissal of this matter. A copy of the *Amended Final Determination* was attached to the June 18, 2013, letter. Accordingly, I issue the following orders:

ORDER: Complainant's request to withdraw its appeal is **GRANTED**.

FURTHER ORDER: This matter is **DISMISSED**.
