ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter arises under the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (“WIOA”), Pub. L. No. 113-128, 128 Stat. 1425 (2014).¹

On July 11, 2016, the United States Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration (“Respondent”), through a Grant Officer, issued a final determination denying the application of Self-Help Enterprises (“Complainant”) for funding pursuant to the National Farmworker Jobs Program (“NFJP”), FOA-ETA-16-02. On July 19, 2016, at Complainant’s request, Respondent issued a feedback letter via email. On August 9, 2016, the Office of Administrative Law Judges (“OALJ” or “Office”) received Complainant’s request for hearing pursuant to § 186(a) of the WIOA.

On August 30, 2016, Complainant filed a letter requesting to withdraw its appeal request. Complainant indicates that it has received a Notice of Award for the NFJP.

As all the issues between the parties have been resolved, and a hearing is no longer necessary, the matter is hereby DISMISSED.
