**ORDER OF DISMISSAL**

On December 8, 2000, the Office of Administrative Law Judges received Employer's request for expedited review pursuant to 8 U.S.C. § 1188(e) and 20 C.F.R. § 655.112(a), of an Employment and Training Administration (ETA) Regional Certifying Officer's declination of Employer's application for temporary alien agricultural labor certification for the occupation of Base Level Bulb/Flower Production Supervisor.
