ORDER REMANDING CASE

On February 16, 2016, the Office of Administrative Law Judges received a letter from Carlson Farms (“Employer”) requesting a de novo hearing regarding the Notice of Deficiency issued by the Certifying Officer in the above-captioned H-2A temporary alien labor certification matter. *See* 8 U.S.C. §§ 1101(a)(15)(H)(ii)(a), 1184(c)(1), and the implementing regulations promulgated at 20 C.F.R. Part 655. On February 18, 2016, the undersigned received from counsel for the Certifying Officer (“the Solicitor”) a motion requesting the case be remanded to the agency for additional processing. The Solicitor states that Employer has no objection to the motion.

In light of the foregoing, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that this matter is **REMANDED** to the Certifying Officer for additional processing.
