ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITHOUT PREJUDICE

The parties, by and through their Counsel pursuant to a Stipulation entered into January 30, 1987, made a part hereof as Exhibit 1, do agree that this matter shall be Dismissed pursuant to 29 C.F.R. §18.39(b).

This Order of Dismissal shall be without prejudice on the grounds that the U.S. Department of Labor, Employment and Training Administration withdraws its Final Notice of Noncompliance dated September 21, 1981 which disallowed certain State Matching Funds under the WIN (Work Incentive Program) program. Said withdrawal does not constitute a concession on the merits by either party and the matter will be transferred to the proper federal agency (the Family Support Administration, U.S. Department of Health and Human Services), for administrative review in the Agency's normal course of business.

The United States Department of Labor having withdrawn its Final Notice of Noncompliance, without prejudice, the State of Maryland DHR, now requests this matter to be dismissed without prejudice, pursuant to 29 C.F.R. §18.39(b).
