

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On February 7, 1984, Van Fleet Orchards requested a hearing in regard to the Department's determination that it was ineligible to apply for temporary labor certification in 1984. I have recently been informed by DOL's Employment and Training Administration that subsequently the complainant was permitted to file for certification, and pursuant to such application it did in fact hire aliens for the 1984 growing season.
