ORDER DENYING MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM JUDGMENT

Now before the Court is Plaintiff's Motion for Relief from Judgment Due to Mistake (Doc. No. 56). Plaintiff seeks reconsideration of the Court's order dismissing his claims. But the issues in this case have been fully litigated. The Court dismissed Plaintiff's claims on February 23, 2010 for lack of subject matter jurisdiction. The Court then denied Plaintiff's motion to reconsider, and Plaintiff appealed. The appellate court recently upheld the dismissal. Plaintiff's most recent motion has presented no basis to reopen this litigation.
