### ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This case arises under the Job Training Partnership Act, 29 U.S.C. §§ 1501, *et seq.*, and the applicable regulations issued at 20 C.F.R. Part 627. Pursuant to a Continuance Order and Notice of Hearing, dated August 24, 2001, I set a hearing date of October 30, 2001 for this case in Gainesville, Florida. On October 26, 2001, I received notice from Ms. Mathews that the parties had settled their dispute and no longer needed an administrative hearing. On November 9, 2001, I received the parties' Joint Stipulation of Dismissal with Prejudice.
